Here's his new QTH and tower. Don says the mountain is beautiful, but unfortunately very close on the southwest side. House elevation is about 4800 feet, and mountain peak is around 9000 feet and just 2 1/2 miles away. The station seems to do well though and he has a clear shot in other directions. Fortunately there isn't much DX southwest of there... just the vast southeast pacific and antarctica.

NN5O Operates as EI2VNO from County Kerry, Northern Ireland



Just like last year, I shipped out to County Kerry, Ireland (Cahirsiveen to be exact), for the CQWW SSB test to operate as EI2VNO. There is a terrific campground at Mannix Point, which works great with the Dublin “hired” motorhome. The view was fantastic as was the play over the salt water to the North Atlantic. With a much improved homebrew groundplane for 15, topping out at a little over 30 feet, I got both DX and some groundwave contacts. Totals for the low power single band 15 effort: 839 Qs, 23 Zones and 96 Countries for 173,264 Points, according to WriteLog—triple the score from last year. Gear: FT-857, Clear Speech block and HM-10 Heil boom/mike.
