ELECTION RESULTS: According to the club by-laws, candidates for president and vice president were lawfully nominated during October, found eligible, and were voted on during November. Sealed ballots were opened and counted on November 30 by K5KYU and WA5LES. R. Jan Carman, W5SBX, received the most votes and Richard L. King, K5PFL, received the second most votes. They, therefore, are the President and Vice President, respectively, of the TDXS for 1977. Congratulations!

THE OTHER THING: Included in the ballot mailing was another document which was voted upon. It read as follows: "The following questions are submitted for vote of the General Membership:

1. Do you favor submission of contest logs for CQWDX, ARRLSS and ARRLDX contests by all TDXS members to only one of the two clubs under consideration?
2. To which of the two clubs would you submit your scores?"

The result of the voting was as follows: With 63% of the members voting, 90% answered "Yes" to the first question and 10% voted "No." The second question, 80% said TDXS, 15% said TACO and 5% had no preference. Precisely what all this means will have to be decided by the new administration in the ensuing months.


